Tom Gibbons, Madison County State's Attorney, advised that his office reached out to the Illinois Attorney General's (AG) office on this topic. After researching the issue, the AG's office noted there were no existing Attorney General's Office opinions or case law regarding this, and, therefore, it would not fall within their jurisdiction.

Since it is a budgeting process, not a levying process, as MCT does not issue a levy, it would be a substantial compliance standard. Considering the District publishes its proposed budget on the website giving notice to the public, offering the opportunity to review the budget ahead of time and weigh in on it, the District has been in substantial compliance.

At Chairman Jedda's request, Mr. Gibbons indicated he would provide the District with a memo concerning the discussion with the Illinois Attorney General's Office.

ORDINANCE NO. 20-02

ADOPTION OF THE ANNUAL OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGET AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

OF THE MADISON COUNTY MASS TRANSIT DISTRICT MADISON COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Section 2. The Budget and Appropriation containing an estimate of revenues and expenditures for the Operating and Capital Funds, as set forth in Attachments A and B are hereby adopted.

Section 3. If any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section 2. The Budget and Appropriation containing an estimate of revenues and expenditures for the Operating and Capital Funds, as set forth in Attachments A and B are hereby adopted.

Section 3. If any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.
