**WHAT:** Madison County Transit (MCT) will be providing FREE shuttle service to and from World Wide Technology Raceway (WWTR) this Saturday and Sunday for the Enjoy Illinois 300 NASCAR Cup Series.

**WHEN:** Saturday, June 4, 7:00 a.m.- 6:00 p.m. AND  
Sunday, June 5, 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

**DETAILS:** More than 50,000 people from nearly every state and multiple countries are expected to attend the Enjoy Illinois 300 events at WWTR. With limited parking at the raceway, riding the MCT shuttle from Madison County or St. Clair County Transit District's free shuttle from St. Clair County are the fastest, most convenient, and most affordable ways to reach the festivities. *Madison County Transit (MCT) provides multi-modal transportation services for Madison County, Illinois. MCT operates a fixed-route bus service, connecting to MetroLink; express weekday commuter service directly to and from downtown St. Louis; and seasonal express service to the Muny. For elderly and disabled residents who are unable to use the fixed-route buses, MCT provides curb to curb service. MCT is also responsible for the construction and maintenance of more than 137 miles of bikeways that comprise the MCT Trails system, as well as overseeing RideFinders, the St. Louis region's FREE carpooling and vanpooling program.*
